City of Binghamton Rules & Regulations

- 1) Plumbing Contractor must contact the City's Sewer Department, 772-7233 before any work is started.
- 2) All contractors must comply with the Rules and Regulations of the City of Binghamton and with the New York State Plumbing Code.
- 3) A Street Work Permit is required for all work within the City of Binghamton's Right of Way.
- 4) It is the Plumbing Contractor's responsibility to make a proper connection to the City's sewer lateral; the City will not make any adjustment to the City side of the lateral. If proper slope can not be attained the Contractor must cease any further work. The Plumbing Contractor is responsible to notify the property owner immediately if proper connection cannot be made and that an adjustment in the structure may be necessary to make the proper connection. The contractor shall also contact the City's Sewer Dept. and the City Engineering Office to inform them of the problem.
- 5) No work shall be covered without an inspection.
- 6) Permit must be posted in a conspicuous location.
- 7) The applicant signing is a duly authorized agent of the owner to obtain a Sewer Lateral Permit in his/her name and affirms that all information is true and correct. Applicant agrees that all work being done conforms to all applicable codes.
