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## MARRIAGE TRANSCRIPT & GENEALOGY INFORMATION

### Transcripts

Requests for information pertaining to marriages that occurred **within the past fifty years** may be made by either party to the marriage, by the designated powers of attorney, or by direct descendants provided that both parties to the marriage are deceased.

The Binghamton City Clerk's Office maintains records of marriage licenses issued within the City of Binghamton. If a document is not found within our records, you may want to contact the Clerks in surrounding municipalities.

Photo identification must be presented upon request for a marriage transcript, along with a \$10 fee payable by cash, money order or local bank check. If requesting a marriage transcript by mail, please enclose a certified check or money order for \$10 made payable to the City of Binghamton, the written request including the groom's name, the bride's maiden name, the date of marriage, and a copy of your photo identification.
