ORDINANCE
entitled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF BINGHAMTON SECTION 170-10.

WHEREAS, the Code of the City of Binghamton §§ 170.8 and 9 prohibit an open container containing any alcoholic beverage on any public land within the City; and

WHEREAS, § 170.10 provides exceptions to this prohibition; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to clarify the exceptions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. "That § 170-10 of the Code of the City of Binghamton, New York, is hereby deleted in its entirety and is replaced as follows: "Exceptions. The above prohibitions shall not apply if the City Clerk has issued a Miscellaneous Activity Permit, with a statement of intent to serve alcohol, for use of a designated public highway, street, sidewalk, park, playground, or parking area; and, if necessary, the applicant has approval from the New York State Liquor Authority."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.
