

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 379,
TAXICABS, IN THE CITY OF BINGHAMTON CODE
OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law § 181 provides that municipalities may enact ordinances to regulate taxicabs and other livery motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Binghamton has enacted Chapter 379, Taxicabs, to regulate taxicabs and other livery motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that the fine structure needs to be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Binghamton, duly convened in regular session, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Code of the City of Binghamton, Chapter 379 *Taxicabs*, is amended and restated as attached hereto.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

§ 379-4. Failure to comply; penalties.

Any owner or operator of a taxicab and any taxicab driver failing to comply with the provisions of this chapter shall, in addition to being subject to having his or her license suspended or revoked by Binghamton City Court, be punished as provided in § 379-23 of this chapter.

§ 379-23. Penalties for offenses. [Amended 5-16-2005 by Ord. No. 05-27]

Any owner and/or operator found to be in violation of any of the following sections shall be subject to the following penalties: § 379-3, 379-5, 376-6, 379-7, 379-11, 379-12, 379-13, 379-14, 379-15, 379-16, 379-17, 379-20 or 379-21 of this chapter:

- A. A minimum fine of \$100, but not exceeding \$500, for a first offense, and/or suspension of license/permit for a period not to exceed one year.
- B. A minimum fine of \$500, but not exceeding \$1,000, for a second offense within a three-year period, and/or suspension of license/permit for a period not to exceed one year.
- C. A fine of \$1,000 for a third and all subsequent offenses within a three-year period, and/or suspension of license/permit for a period not to exceed one year.
